



In March 28 of this year the event "European Union Missions and "European Horizon" - Lithuanian Municipalities for Climate Change Solutions" organized by the Lithuanian Science Council and the Association of Lithuanian Municipalities was held in Vilnius. Representatives of municipalities and academic institutions participated in the event.

During the event the participants were introduced to a wide range of climate topics of the European Union (EU) missions and the "European Horizon" (EH) program, reviewed the EU missions "Impact climate-neutral and smart cities", "Adaptation to climate change", "Healthy soil and food" calls for applications and the opportunities provided by action groups 5 and 6 of the EH program, practical aspects of application preparation were discussed and success stories were shared.

The representatives of the municipal administration of Biržai district were invited to share their experience of participating in the European Commission program HORIZON-MISS-2022-CLIMA-01-06 project "Acceleration and integration of solutions based on transformative natural processes in order to increase resilience to climate change in various biogeographical regions of Europe" (NATALIE), as the only Lithuanian representatives from 11 countries in this project.
